The status of Swiss members is still very unsatisfying. Because of reducing traveling budget, the attendance to our conferences or workgroup meetings get always more difficult.

### 5. Publicity of IFIP TC11

The Swiss PhD students know the IFIP SEC conferences. According to international rankings your conference is not top rated. Because of the low rating, we may get only about 100 papers to review. About 30 papers are required to offer an interesting conference program. Therefore our acceptance rate is around 30% what is very high and reduces our conference rating.

We try to increase the attention of the conference by ads in Google Adwords.
