Work Programme 2011

This year's programme deals both with awareness-raising about key issues in the field of education and ICT and developing rich input into policy-making processes by engaging a wide range of actors in the formulation of key issues and related recommendations that are subsequently presented to the relevant authorities and bodies. This work involves several activities: an online seminar on the L4D platform about social networks and learning; the collection of potential key issues in ICT and education on L4D; a workshop in Münchenwiler; and later in the year a series of online working groups on selected key issues to draw up recommendations; publication and diffusion.



Two-day workshop in Münchenwiler

The workshop will take place in the Münchenwiler Castle from **April 1st 9:30 - April 2nd 14:00**.

The workshop has a double goal:

1. Selecting a set of four key issues for which recommendations will subsequently be developed online and face-to-face;
2. Increasing awareness and experience of the use of social networks and online communities as contexts for peer exchange and learning.
