Internet provides support to international school co-operation.

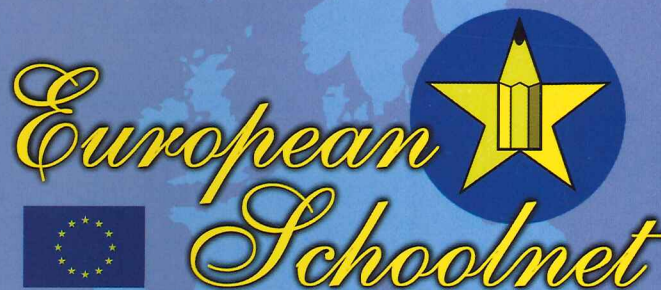
Internet can be integrated to curriculum work and provides an excellent tool for learning.

What is the Internet?

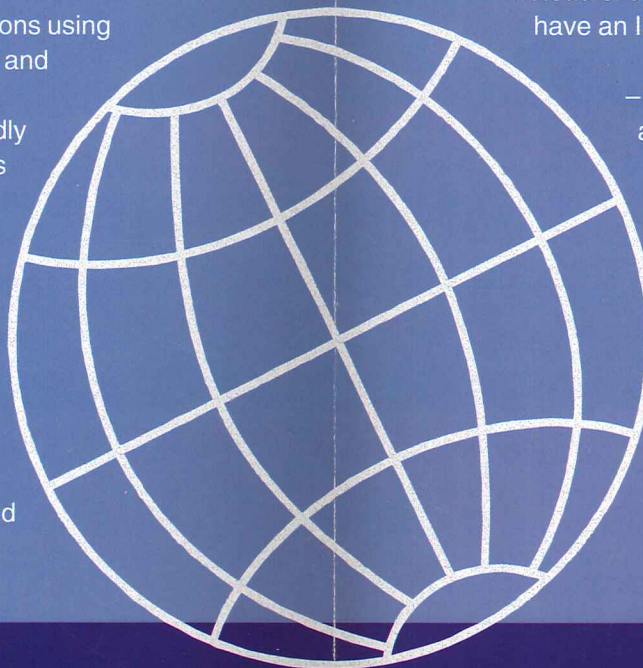
A global electronic information network with 100 000s of databases.

A network for communications using texts, documents, pictures and sound.

Internet connects to a rapidly growing number of services for your everyday life.

What do you need to get started?

- Access to a computer, PC or Mac.
- A subscription to Internet services. Internet subscription is offered by many network operators and other organisations on the market.



- A connection to Internet via a modem and telephone line or via a Local Area Network. Instead of a modem connection you can have an ISDN line, which is faster but a bit more expensive.
- Software for communication and information access goes with the Internet subscription and may also be downloaded from Internet.
